

Curriculum Vitae Professor Dr. Luís Greco (LL.M.)

Luís (Filipe Maksoud) Greco was born in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, in 27th March 1978, son to Leonardo Greco (attorney in law; professor for Civil Procedure) and Ana Maria Maksoud Greco. The main landmarks of his academic education are: Study of Law in the Faculdade de Direito da Universidade Federal do Rio de Janeiro, Brazil (1996-2000); LL.M. in Ludwig-Maximilians-Universität (LMU) München, Brazil (2001-2003); Ph.D. in this same institution with a summa cum laude thesis about „The Living and the Dead in Feuerbachs Theory of Punishment“ (2003-2008), under the supervision of prof. dr. Claus Roxin, a thesis which has been awarded by the Bavarian Academy of Sciences with the Max Weber Preis; „Habilitation“ in the same institution with a thesis about „Theory of Criminal Procedure and Res Iudicata“ (2008-2014), under the supervision of prof. dr. Bernd Schünemann; study of Law in the LMU (2008-2015), with the first legal exam 2015 (final note: 12,63 points).

Prof. Greco was an Academic Assistant to prof. Schünemann from 2004 to 2013. Starting April 2015 he held the „Professur“ for Criminal Law, Criminal Procedure and Economic Criminal Law in the Universität Augsburg, Germany. He has received and accepted a call („Ruf“) to the Humboldt-Universität zu Berlin, where he holds a Chair for Criminal Law, Criminal Procedure, Foreign Criminal Law and Criminal Law Theory since Oct. 2017.

Prof. Greco is co-author of important commentaries on German Law: Leipziger Kommentar zum Strafgesetzbuch, Systematischer Kommentar zum Strafgesetzbuch, Systematischer Kommentar zur Strafprozessordnung. He is also coeditor of the Leipziger Kommentar and of the most reputed journal in Germany, the Zeitschrift für die gesamte Strafrechtswissenschaft. He is a honorable member of the Criminal Law Society of Japan. His main current project is the next edition of his Ph.D.-supervisor's (Roxin) Treatise on the General Part of Criminal Law, whose first volume appeared in 2020 and whose second volume is about to be finished.
