

## SOFIA DE VASCONCELOS CASIMIRO

### *BIO IN BRIEF*

Sofia de Vasconcelos Casimiro is a Professor of Law at Lisbon School of Law, University of Lisbon, and at the Portuguese Military Academy and has also taught at the NATO Communications and Information Systems School, at the European Security and Defence College and at the European Defence Agency as an expert in Information and Communication Technologies (ICT) Law. She works with the Portuguese Army in cybersecurity and cyberdefence matters and, as a lawyer in ICT Law since the nineties, she has been providing legal advice to the National Defence Ministry, the Ministry of Justice and to some of the big tech companies, including some of the Big Five, such as major search engine operators, content providers, Internet service providers and operators of critical infrastructures. Currently she is also a member of the Implementation Working Group of the Cyber Academy and Innovation Hub and a member of the Board of Directors of the Portuguese Society for Intellectual Property Law. Sofia holds a doctorate in Information Technologies and Law from Queen Mary, University of London and she is the author and co-author of several publications, including the book "Data Protection in the Internet".
